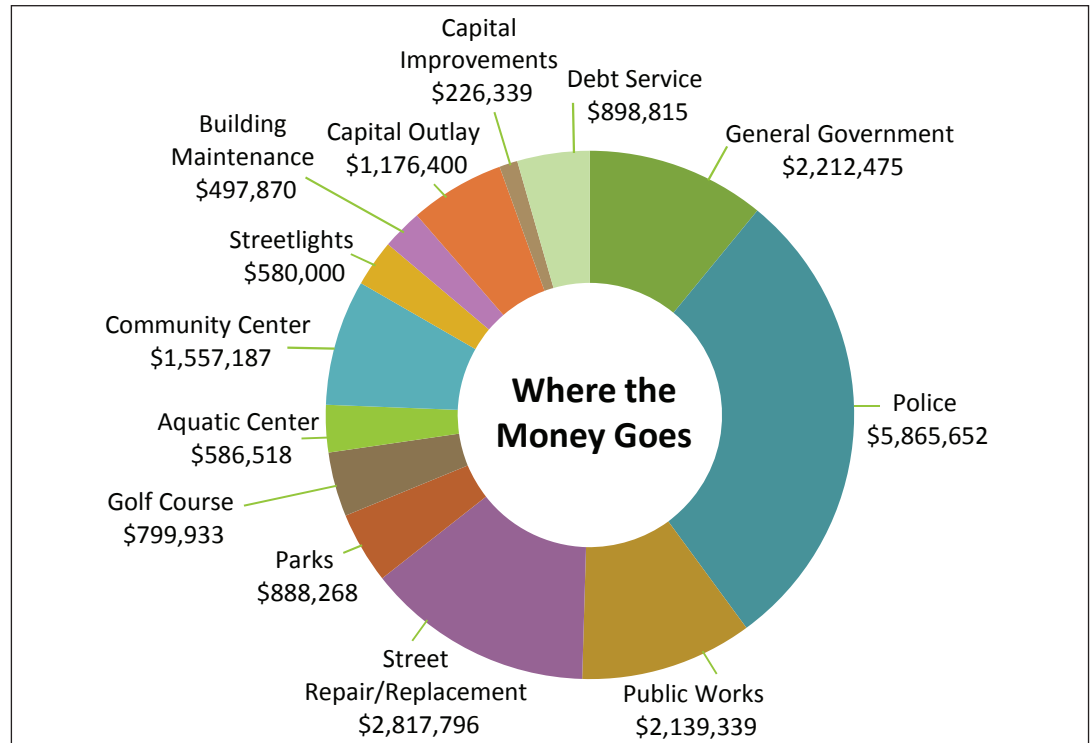
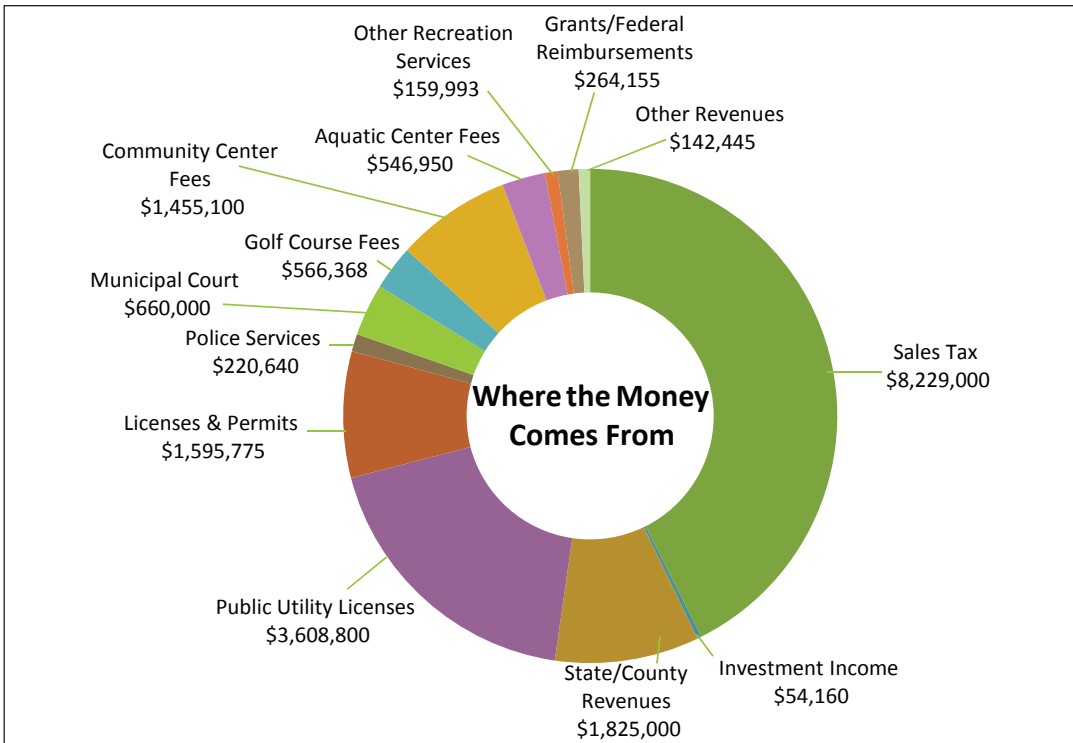
### Understanding the 2016 Budget

The 2016 Budget is the City of Ballwin's fiscal plan for the next year. It sets the goals and objectives the City wants to accomplish, including capital improvements, street repairs and police programs. The budget projects revenues that

the City anticipates collecting and its predicted expenditures during the fiscal year (January 1 - December 31).

The total operating budget and capital improvement plan is \$20,246,592. The graphs

below help illustrate revenues, expenditures and capital improvements for the 2016 fiscal year. Capital improvements focus primarily on engineering and easement expenses for major road and culvert projects.

The city is currently accepting applications for lifeguarding positions. Red Cross Lifeguard training classes are available beginning April 22 and May 31. Employment applications are available on the city's website.

The Ballwin Blue Dolphin Swim and Dive Teams are gearing up for another summer of fun and fitness for kids 5-18 years of age. Evening as well as early morning practice times will be available this summer with multi-family discounts. Swimming lessons are also available this summer or float the lazy river at a Twilight Swim on June 18, July 9 and August 13.

## 2016 Public Works Projects

The City of Ballwin contracted with M&H Concrete Contractors to remove the old asphalt surface and replace selected underlying concrete pavement on Timka Drive, Amber Jack Drive, Andante Drive, Pine Tree Lane, White Tree Lane, White Tree Court, and Mansionhill Drive-Phase 1 (Gardenway to #920). Once this work is completed, Krupp Construction will repave these streets during the summer.

M&H Concrete Contractors will also replace selected concrete pavement sections on Lering Court and Drive, Alverston Court (south of Westglen Drive), Pine Hollow Court, and Westrun Drive (west of Westglen Village Drive). The entire pavement on Guenevere Drive (Rotherham to Hollyridge Court), Hollyridge Drive (Hollyridge Court to Dutch Mill Drive) will be replaced with concrete in a similar manner as Guenevere Drive (Henry to Rotherham) in 2015.

M&H will also upgrade sidewalks

and curb ramps to meet current ADA standards on the above mentioned streets.

A special micropaving pavement surface treatment will be applied on Bedford Lane, Lennox Drive, Geremma Drive and Court, Westglen Village Drive (asphalt section), Village Creek Drive and Court, Cedar Village Court, Hollyridge Drive (Dutch Mill Drive to Dutch Mill Drive), Agean Way, and Jares Court.

The City contracted with CDG Engineers to design a new bridge on Ramsey Lane at Fishpot Creek. The existing culvert's deficiency rating made it eligible for 80% federal funding. Construction is scheduled for 2018.

Easements will be acquired in 2016 for the Henry Avenue Resurfacing and Sidewalk Project and the Ries Road Bridge Replacement Project. Construction for both projects is scheduled for 2017 and are 80% federally funded.

## Special Pickups from Republic Services

Solid waste collection service in Ballwin is provided under a contract with Republic Services. In addition to the normal trash and recycling pickup services, Republic also provides a bulky trash pickup service

for items that cannot be placed inside the provided containers. These household items like furniture or mattresses will be picked up on a call-in basis on the last pickup day of the month and are limited

to two items a month. To arrange for this pickup, call Republic customer service at 636-947-5959. Similarly, pickup of major appliances (white goods) can be arranged by calling Republic. Tires,

batteries and construction materials are excluded from these special pickups. There is no extra charge for either of these services.
