Bill 4197 - AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE EXCEPTION TO MOHAMMAD AND OMAR AYYASH FOR MELT N DIP, FOR OPERATION OF A RESTAURANT WITH FRONT YARD PARKING AND OUTSIDE SEATING.

This ordinance is for a Special Use Exception for a new restaurant at 15575 and 15577 Manchester Road called Melt N' Dip.

Bill 4198 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE IDENTIFICATION AND DUTIES OF THE RECORD CUSTODIAN IN THE CITY OF BALLWIN.

This ordinance corrects the records custodian section of the Ballwin Code of Ordinances.
