

When Brian Mitchell started looking for a new challenge at the beginning of this year, he hit the ground running. Literally.


The Ballwin resident decided to run every mile of every street in Ballwin. The St. Charles native and his Ballwin native wife have called Ballwin home for the last 11 years.

His running challenges started back in 2019, just before the pandemic hit. When the world shut down, "I needed a challenge that would specifically force me to be outside," Brian says.

He started running. "So in 2020, I did 750 miles, and I was like, wow that's cool. And then I increased it to 800 and some, and then so last year, in 2022, I did 1,000," he says. "I was kind of looking for what else to do."

So he turned to our City streets, pounding the pavement and visiting every square inch of the City's 508 streets.





In total, that makes 150 miles of streets. But Brian logs far more miles than that, since he added in a twist. All runs have to start and end at his home on the City's north side. So he treks back and forth across areas he's already run to be able to cross off another street on his map. "(I'll) put in 9 miles to get a mile of new coverage," Brian explains.

But his colorful map is not the only product of his runs across town.



He's also an artist, who sees the beauty in discarded junk while cleaning up the roads at the same time. "While I run I pick up whatever little metal stuff I find on the road," he says of his sculptures.

He makes metal sculptures out of what he finds, shaping them into runners, archers, elephants, whales and anything else that comes to mind. "I like to joke that the whole city had a part in making this," he says.

Brian hopes to finish his City running project by the end of the year. He's a little less than halfway through right now.



DETECTIVE RAY RADER



We sat down with Detective Ray Rader and how the transition to the bureau is, what types of cases intrigue him the most, and what he believes he brings to the table to the bureau and how he can build on an already promising career.

A few months back, the Ballwin Police Department filled a position within the Bureau of Investigation. Detective Rader, who has been a police officer for the City of Ballwin for more than 8 years was reassigned from patrol. Detective Rader is a field training officer, crime scene investigator, CIT, and a firearms instructor. He has worn many hats while on patrol and in his short but promising career.

As of now, he is the newest detective within the bureau. Fortunately for him, he wore many hats while on patrol that have given him a solid foundation for his new adventure. Detective Rader described the transition as a change of pace from patrol. He spends his time now calling people to gather additional information, looking at surveillance footage, knocking on doors, and typing new reports.

Detective Rader says he aims to be the best officer he can be, so he can provide the residents of Ballwin with the highest quality of service possible.

Vacation Checks

With school almost at an end, longer days around the corner, and summer nearly here, many may have family vacations planned. Planning a vacation and the itinerary to go along with it can be very stressful. To make matters worse, now you need to make plans for the dogs, cats, or fish, mail, possibly the yard, and even your home. There are just not enough hours in a day for someone to manage all that, and without possibly forgetting something. Not to mention the stress of worrying if your house will be safe while you're gone. That's where Ballwin Police Department will step in.

The Ballwin Police Department offers a variety of programs that are listed on our city website. One of those programs that can benefit you, your family, and limit your stress levels is the Vacation Check. The vacation check program is a small form that can be filled out electronically. The form will ask for dates, an alarm system, security cameras, lights on/off, vehicles on the property, if anyone will have a key and or stay on the property, as well as emergency contact information.

Any vacation that is less than three weeks, officers will check the residence every day. They will log the results on a form with date and time, as well as log the call in our CAD system. If you have a vacation planned, please give us a call and let us help you to alleviate some of that stress.

Watering the Greens

Deciding how much water to apply on a golf course putting green is a difficult decisions that superintendents must make daily. At night the irrigation system will water the greens. That water is targeted to get into the root zone of the turf. If the green is over watered, it becomes soft and spongy, resulting in a slow playing surface.

Having a green too wet during the heat is one of the worst things. When a green is saturated with water, the water heats up during the day, which heats up the soil and cooks the roots. Then at night, when temperatures drop the hot water keeps the soil hot all night, so the roots cannot recover from the hot afternoons. When the humidity is high, it is very hard to dry greens out once they become saturated. Greens are also more likely to get fungus or disease under these conditions.

Having a green too dry can also negatively affect the turf health, but in general, it is better to have the greens dryer than wetter. Therefore, when scheduling overnight watering, our Golf Course Superintendent tends to err on the dry side.

This means there isn't enough water to maintain optimal playing conditions thoughout a hot day. So a light application of water is needed thoughout the afternoon to ensure the greens survive the heat stress.

This is done by hand watering the greens, which just cools off the top surface area. On a hot day, about 4-5 light applications of water is needed. Hand watering assures that the whole putting surface gets what it need to survive the heat. Some areas need a little more water and some areas might not need any extra water.

This is why we typically don't use sprinklers in the afternoon on greens. If it happens to be windy out, the wind can blow water away from areas of the green. That means some areas wouldn't get any water, and some areas would get too much.

Sprinklers also hit cart paths, so turning them on during a busy day would get carts and golfers wet. Hand watering provides greater control over where and how much water is applied to an area.

While this process might inconvenience golfers, the inconvenience is worth it for maintaining healthy putting green surfaces.


