The town of Ballshow on the defterson Road 21 miles west of St. Louis and 2 miles west of the Manchester. The town is laid out in Squares of 104 ted 6 inches by the same in depth. and the Street all running right angles. Main Street being 60 teet in width, the other 40 feet. Februar 7th 1839 dosiah H. Davisson Surv.

The above town is named <u>BallWill</u> it embraces within its limits about twenty three acres of land It is bounded on the South by the road leading from St. Louis to defferson city, on the west by land now owned by the undersigned and also on the north east 4 south by me the undersigned proprietor. The course of First or Main Street is North 7612 W. The other Streets running west wardly are paralell thereto, and the cross streets are at right angles therefrom. The streets as laid down in the above plat. And also Blocks numbered 15 × 16 are relinquished to the use of the inhabitants of the town of Ballwin. The first named Block as a site for the Erection of a meeting house for the Methodist Episcolpal Congregation 4 shoolhouse and Block No. 16 for a burring ground for the use of the inhabitants of said town and for no other purpose. Ballmin February 9th 1837 Clohn Ball.

Missouri, County of St. Louis, s.s. Beit remembered that on this ninth day of February eighteen hundred and thirty seven before me the undersigned Clerk of the Circuit Court. within and for the County

John Ball, who had originally named the property south of his homestead "Ballshow", changed the name to "Ballwin" two days later, purportedly to demonstrate his desire that he would "win" the competition with Manchester as a stage/mail stop on the road from St. Louis to Jefferson City.

On Februry 9th, 1837, John produced a plat map of the sixty-eight squares (measuring 104 feet, six inches on each side) of the approximately twenty-three acres that comprised the land that he had surveyed for the town he called Ballwin. As a Methodist, John Ball set aside square 15 for the German Methodist Episcopal congregation to build a "meeting house" and school and square 16 for a cemetery to be maintained for the city by the congregation. This was the original location of Salem in Ballwin United Methodist Church's sanctuary until the current sanctuary was

built in 1869-70, at which point the original building served as Ballwin's first public schoolhouse until it was replaced in 1900 at the same location by the Old Ballwin Schoolhouse. The Old Ballwin Schoolhouse was later moved to its current location to make room for the Old Towne shopping plaza.

Serve Your Community - By Working as a St. Louis County Election Judge

Play a big part in the upcoming April 2nd St. Louis County General Municipal Election by becoming a St Louis County Election Judge! The St. Louis County Election Board needs to staff more than 200 polling places throughout the county, and you can help. Bi-partisan teams of Election Judges at each poll are vital to citizens exercising their right to vote. Election Judges are responsible for essential tasks such as setting up and operating voting equipment, managing the voting process by checking in voters, and securing ballots for collection at the Election Board. High school students are also needed to assist official Election Judges at the polls. Students shadow experienced judges through an innovative Student Election Judge program. Students will learn how the electoral process works and the importance of public service beginning at a young age. Election Judges can earn at least \$250 for their service. Students can earn \$170 or 16 community service hours that many schools require for graduation. I am pleased to present the City of Ballwin's 2024 Budget. The budget serves as the City's fiscal plan from January 1, 2024 – December 31, 2024. It includes our goals, objectives, and future financial projections. I've included graphs that show the City of Ballwin's projected revenues and expenditures. To view the budget in its entirety, please visit our Budgets page on the City's website. We are committed to making the budgeting process as open and transparent as possible, so please reach out to the City directly if you have any additional questions or concerns.

Total revenues equal \$26,461,955. Major revenues for the City of Ballwin include sales taxes, public utility licenses, and community programs. The City has \$0 property tax, so it is reliant on the categories included in the chart above.

SALES TAXES represent \$11.9 million or 45% of General and Capital Fund revenues. Ballwin consumers pay a sales tax rate of 8.738% of which .5% is for Capital Improvements and .5% is for Parks. An additional 1.0% is distributed from St. Louis County. These revenues are highly variable depending on economic conditions.

PUBLIC UTILITY LICENSES represent \$3.2 million or 12% of General and Capital Fund revenues. A gross receipts tax is paid by both public and private utility companies doing business in Ballwin for use of the public right-of-way and is based on operating revenues. These companies generally pass the tax on to their customers.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS represent \$3.7 million or 14% of General and Capital Fund revenues. Memberships and fees from Ballwin's community center, golf course and outdoor water park generate these revenues. Additional sources include special programs such as race events, community festivals and facility rentals.





Total expenditures equal \$27,049,016. Police, Public Works, and Capital Improvements make up a significant portion of the City of Ballwin's 2024 Budget.

POLICE represents 33% of the General Fund. Included is the replacement of 4 patrol vehicles, tasers, and a new cloud based video recording system for officers (body worn cameras) and patrol vehicles.

PUBLIC WORKS represents 27% of the General Fund and includes road resurfacing, sidewalk repairs and snow and leaf removal. Trimming and removal of trees in the right-of-way is also performed.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS total \$3.1 million and represent all expenditures for the Capital Fund. Construction of a new playground in Vlasis Park, resurfacing of Ries Road and design work for reconfiguration of the Public Works yard are all planned.

Last year, the City of Ballwin was presented with a Distinguished Budget Presentation Award from the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) for the 2023 budget. This is the eighth consecutive award for the City. This award certifies Ballwin's budget documents were of the highest quality and rated proficient in serving as: a policy document, a financial plan, an operations guide and a communications device.

The City of Ballwin's budget document consists of its primary General Fund, a Capital Improvements Fund, and several minor funds such as a Sewer Lateral Fund, TDD Fund, and a Federal Asset Seizure Fund. Every fall, each department drafts an estimate of projects and their expenses to present to the Board of Aldermen for consideration, which they then work to solidify and prioritize the remainder of the year.

Mental Health Check

Winter is here, with low temperatures, cold brisk wind, sunless days, and a gloomy atmosphere in full tilt. You may not know it, but the weather can play a part in one's mental health. Many studies have been conducted across the globe, and the combination of cold weather, and lack of social life can help develop seasonal depression.

For some people, once spring, warmer temperatures, or even sunlight start happening again, the seasonal depression slowly disappears. Every now and then, it still lingers. If that is the case, or you know someone who is struggling, whether it's depression, bi-polar, anxiety, etc., call us. We can help and provide additional resources as well.

The Ballwin Police Department has nearly ninety percent (90%) of its staff CIT certified. CIT, Crisis Intervention Team, is designed for officers to focus on de-escalation techniques and better understanding of what someone may be experiencing. The training consists of recognizing the signs and symptoms of various mental illnesses. Ballwin PD works with many organizations that help with mental illness.

Ballwin PD works closely with these resources, and has a community mental health liaison that conducts additional follow ups. This allows both parties to see progress of assistance, and if needed come up with a plan for additional support and services. Tax Season

Why don't skunks pay taxes? They only have one scent.

Tax season is definitely nothing to laugh at, especially the number of tax-related identity theft crimes. It's unfortunately becoming very common. In the past few years, tax-related identity theft reports have been on the rise, with more than 1.5 million reports as recent as 2022.

The IRS has publicized warning signs to prevent tax-related identity theft:

- Receiving letters or emails from the IRS inquiring about a suspicious tax return
- You're unable to file a tax return due to the duplicate Social Security number
- Receiving a tax transcripts in the mail that you did not request
- Receiving an IRS notice an account has been created in your name
- IRS records indicate you received wages or other income from an employer you didn't work for
- If you have been assigned an Employer Identification Number, when you did not request an EIN.

The Ballwin Police Department offers many community programs. One program the department would like to highlight is the Caring Partners Program. This service is designed for our older residents, or anyone that may struggle living alone. Enrolled residents receive a phone call at their designated time. If the resident is unable to answer the phone, police are sent to the residence to check on the welfare of the participant.

Elderly, disabled, or those who struggle to live alone are encouraged to take advantage of the FREE service. A simple enrollment form being complete is all that is required.
