In 1990, when members of the Ballwin Historical Commission were talking about how nice it would be to have one of the original log homes that had been in this area, Verna Dahlke Arnold said, "Oh, I grew up in one of them. It's still there!" Over the course of time, the home had been covered with siding on the outside and paneling on the inside. Through the joint efforts of the City of Ballwin and the Ballwin Historical Commission, the home was moved log-by-log from its original location near the current Countryside Creek gazebo to where it is now located at the corner of Park Drive and Holloway Road.

I am pleased to present the City of Ballwin's 2025 Budget. The budget serves as the City's fiscal plan from January 1, 2025 – December 31, 2025. It includes our goals, objectives, and future financial projections. I've included graphs that show the City of Ballwin's projected revenues and expenditures. To view the budget in its entirety, please visit our Budgets page on the City's website. We are committed to making the budgeting process as open and transparent as possible, so please reach out to the City directly if you have any additional questions or concerns.

Total revenues equal \$30,205,906. Major revenues for the City of Ballwin include sales taxes, public utility licenses, and community programs. The City has \$0 property tax, so it is reliant on the categories included in the chart below. This year there is also a transfer in of accumulated fund balance amounting to \$3.4 million.

**SALES TAXES** represent \$12.3 million or 46% of General and Capital Fund revenues. Ballwin consumers pay a sales tax rate of 8.738% of which .5% is for Capital Improvements, .5% is for Public Safey and .5% is for Parks. An additional 1.0% is distributed from St. Louis County. These revenues are highly variable depending on economic conditions.

**PUBLIC UTILITY LICENSES** represent \$3.4 million or 13% of General and Capital Fund revenues. A gross receipts tax is paid by both public and private utility companies doing business in Ballwin for use of the public right-of-way and is based on operating revenues. These companies generally pass the tax on to their customers.

**COMMUNITY PROGRAMS** represent \$4.1 million or 15% of General and Capital Fund revenues. Memberships and fees from Ballwin's community center, golf course and outdoor water park generate these revenues. Additional sources include special programs such as race events, community festivals and facility rentals.

Total expenditures equal \$30,360,270. Police, Public Works, and Capital Improvements make up a significant portion of the City of Ballwin's 2025 Budget.

**POLICE** represents 29% of the General Fund. Included is the replacement of 4 patrol vehicles, replacement of portable radios, and lease payments for tasers and a cloud based video recording system for officers (body worn cameras) and patrol vehicles.

**PUBLIC WORKS** represents 23% of the General Fund and includes road resurfacing, sidewalk repairs and snow and leaf removal. Trimming and removal of trees in the right-of-way is also performed.

**CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS** total \$5.5 million and represent all expenditures for the Capital Fund. Construction of a new playground at The Pointe, resurfacing of Ries Road and construction work for reconfiguration of the Public Works yard are all planned.


Last year, the City of Ballwin was presented with a Distinguished Budget Presentation Award from the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) for the 2024 budget. This is the ninth consecutive award for the City. This award certifies Ballwin's budget documents were of the highest quality and rated proficient in serving as: a policy document, a financial plan, an operations guide and a communications device.

The City of Ballwin's budget document consists of its primary General Fund, a Capital Improvements Fund, and several minor funds including a Sewer Lateral Fund, TDD Fund, and a Federal Asset Seizure Fund. In late summer, each department drafts an estimate of projects and their expenses to present to the Board of Aldermen for consideration, which they then work to solidify and prioritize the remainder of the year.

# Chief's Corner

A question I frequently receive is, why does it take so long to solve a real crime when my favorite TV show is able to do it within an hour? Our Police Officers and Detectives are highly trained and motivated to solve the crimes that occur within our city. We have officers who are fully trained crime scene technicians. They are able to photograph a scene, collect physical evidence and process it for latent evidence (fingerprints, DNA, etc.). This speeds up the process so that perishable evidence is not destroyed while waiting for a detective to respond to a scene. Latent fingerprint and DNA evidence are submitted to regional crime laboratories



for processing and to check to see if a possible suspect is already in the database. Due to the large amount of items submitted for processing, the laboratories prioritize the evidence by the severity of the crime. Evidence from a homicide scene goes to the front of the line, while items seized from a theft from a car may take a long time to be analyzed. If a suspect has never been fingerprinted, or had their DNA collected, it may take a while for a match to be made with the evidence. Crime laboratories have notified us over a year after evidence has been submitted, that they matched a subject who was recently fingerprinted, or had their DNA collected, for a different crime.

Technology is playing a larger role in crime fighting and our detectives are staying at the forefront. When a serious crime occurs, our detectives are able to ask the courts to subpoena cell phone companies for their records to find out who was in the immediate vicinity of the crime scene when it occurred. This sometimes takes time to get the subpoena/search warrant and for the phone companies to respond to the request. The detectives have to then sift through the data to try to find a person of interest. When we identify a subject of interest, the detectives may ask the courts to issue a search warrant to examine the person's electronic devices. Depending on the device, it may take months for a laboratory to examine the evidence contained on the cell phone or tablet. We are also able to examine the data kept on a vehicle's infotainment system and/or event data recorder (blackbox) if a known vehicle was used in a crime or serious crash. Home and business surveillance cameras also are used as a great crime fighting tool. Our detectives will do an area canvas to identify all of the possible cameras that may have captured all or part of a crime.

Technology has given us additional tools to use in our job, but most of the time it is the old fashion methods that solve the crime. Detectives go out and interview witnesses, victims and possible suspects. They examine the evidence left at the scene. The detectives have to piece the puzzle together to show prosecutors, the courts, and sometimes a jury, why a certain person committed a crime. The detectives also have a responsibility to rule a person out as a suspect if the evidence is indicating they did not commit the crime. All of these steps take time and are not able to be done within an hour.

# Register Your Security/Doorbell Camera



Do you know you can register your security camera or video doorbell with The Ballwin Police Department? Security cameras not only provide a little relief for a home owner, giving the ability to see and record what goes on their property, but those cameras can also help the Ballwin Police Department solve crimes, helping keep your neighborhood or business safe.

In many cases, crimes require dozens of hours of investigating and canvassing neighborhoods and businesses. Detectives can utilize those cameras to track the trail a suspect traveled in order to commit a crime, get clear pictures of getaway cars, or even see direct evidence of crimes that have occurred.

Registering your camera with the Ballwin Police Department does NOT give us direct access to your camera. It simply lets us know there's a camera present at that address. So if a crime were to occur in your neighborhood or at your business, we know we can contact you to ask for footage. We cannot get the footage without your permission or a subpoena from the courts.

With many homes adding security cameras and with residents moving in and out of the City, we've made it easy to let us know you have cameras at your residence. We've created a registration form on the city's website. If you are interested in registering, please see the QR code above.
