

Recognize anyone in this photograph?

When the Old Ballwin Schoolhouse was sold in 1938, Mae Duly, the long-time teacher in that building, began teaching at Ballwin Elementary School. In this photo, which was taken on September 17, 1942, Miss Duly is standing third from the left in row 3. Only a few students from her mixed-grade class (grades 5, 6, and 8) are identified in the Ballwin Historical Commission's archives. In the front row, Robert Blinne is seated third from the left, and Randy Loving is seated fifth from the left. Dororthy Motz is seated third from the left in row 2. Only Miss Duly has been identified in row 3. Robert Rasch is standing second from the left in row 4. Nobody has been identified in row 5.

The Ballwin Public Works Department is excited to continue our free residential curbside leaf collection program this fall! This program began on October 28th and will run through the first week of December.

Here are some friendly reminders to help get you and your yard ready for leaf pickup day. For more information, please visit our website.

• There will be at least one crew assigned to each ward (1,2,3 and 4). If you're unsure what ward you live in, use the QR Code to the right.



- Crews will collect leaves Monday through Friday and will begin each day where they ended the day before. You can expect at least 4 passes through your neighborhood.
- If you'd prefer not to wait on our crews, Republic Services will pick up your bagged leaves as part of their yard waste disposal.
- We have created a Master Street List by ward, which is updated every afternoon to help you track crews progress throughout the City. This can be accessed on the Curbside Leaf Collection page under the Public Works section on our website.
- Please rake your leaves to the edge of your property next to the street. Do not pile the leaves up in the street or gutter.
- Do not park on top, or in front of leaf piles.
- This program may be delayed, halted, or ended due to weather conditions, manpower issues, heightened leaf volume, equipment down time, etc.
- There will be no pickup on City-observed holidays (Nov. 28, Nov. 29, Dec. 25, Dec. 25)
- Leaves will NOT be collected from any multi-family units such as apartments, condominiums, or villas.
- Leaves will NOT be collected along private streets within any multi-family complexes or any commercial, school, institutions, or non-City governmental properties.

Chief's Corner

Do you ever wonder who is on the other end of the telephone call when you dial 911? I want to shed light on those professionals who answer these calls. The Ballwin Police Department operates a Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) or a police dispatch center. All 911 calls originating from within the city limits of Ballwin, Winchester or Manchester are directed to our center. They will connect your call to Central County Emergency 911



if you need the fire department or Emergency Medical Services (EMS). They stay on the line while you speak to a fire or EMS dispatcher and will start getting a police officer on the way to your emergency.

We always have a minimum of two Communications Officers on duty at any one time in our dispatch center. We pride ourselves on answering 911, and non-emergency calls, within three rings. You should never receive a message telling you that your 911 call is important and it will be answered in the order received. After a significant car crash, it is not uncommon for our dispatchers to receive multiple calls reporting the emergency. Several years ago, the St. Louis area experienced an earthquake during the early morning hours. I was the overnight Watch Commander, and was in our dispatch center when the calls started coming in. I sat down at an open dispatch station to start answering calls. We ended up answering thirty-five calls within a matter of a minute of the quake. This is just one example of how busy our center can be during emergencies.

Several of our Communications Officers have been with us for over 20 years. This is a major bonus for you, because they know the area and are familiar with current and past businesses. During a crisis, you may refer to a location by an old business name when you are talking to them. Our dispatchers will usually know exactly where you are at or the location you are referring to. They have ways of knowing which of

the four McDonald's, along Manchester Road, you are referring to.

Our Communications Officers work well together. During a crime in progress, or a serious fire or medical emergency, while you are talking to one of our dispatchers, the other communications officer will be dispatching officers to your location and updating them with additional information. This allows us to get officers to you quicker. They have to keep you focused so that you are able to provide valuable information to the responding officers and fire personnel. Our Communications Officers try not to show emotion in their voices while they are dispatching officers to your scene. Their even tone helps keep our officers calm as they respond to assist you.

Our Communications Officers are hidden first responders. They are the first ones to interact with you during an emergency. They provide an invaluable service to our community, but are not visible at the scene of the emergency. They quietly do their jobs without drawing attention to themselves.

We are always looking for the next generation of Communications Officers. If you are interested in pursuing a career as an Communications Officer with the Ballwin Police Department, please check out the employment page in the top righthand corner of ballwin.mo.us.

Officer Jenna Christian, a member of the Ballwin Police Department with over 20 years of police service, has been appointed as a Coordinating Council Board Member with the St. Louis Area Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) Council. This council serves the City of St. Louis, St. Louis County, and numerous municipalities throughout the region, including Ballwin.

The St. Louis Area CIT Coordinating Council is committed to the success and continuous improvement of the Missouri CIT. The council's mission is to enhance law enforcement services for individuals with mental illness, promote awareness

and wellness among individuals, families, and the community. They identify essential resources, collaborate with local service providers and law enforcement agencies, and advocate for addressing the unmet needs of individuals within the St. Louis County region.

All officers of the Ballwin Police Department receive Crisis Intervention Training to better serve the community.

In the summer of 2022, Missouri joined the rest of the United States in using the 988 dialing code. 988 connects those who are experiencing a mental health-related crisis, to the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. People can use 988 if they are having any thoughts of suicide, mental health crisis, substance use crisis, or any other kind of emotional distress. Even if you have a concern for a loved one, you too can utilize 988. For those who may not be comfortable talking on the phone, there is a chat/texting option available as well.





Winter is soon upon us, and with frigid temperatures and blistering winds, many dream of taking a warm vacation just to get away. If you and your family escaping the cold, but worried about the safety of your home while you're away, have no fear! The Ballwin Police Department offers Vacation Checks.

By completing a simple form, which can be found using the QR code, officers will check the exterior residence during the daylight hours. If there is an emergency, the officers will get a hold of the primary contact. And keep us in mind for summer vacations, too! We offer this service year-round.




