Administration - Sewer Lateral Bid

Staff recommends the Board approve a contract from A&A Sewer for the sewer lateral program. This is a program that goes out to bid every two years. Only one company submitted a bid.

Public Works - New Ballwin Road Lighted School Crosswalk Signs

Approximately two years ago the LED lighted School crosswalk systems on New Ballwin Road in front of Selvage Middle school failed. After discovering that we could no longer get replacement parts, the LED yellow warning bar was removed and the LED School crosswalk signs were changed out to standard School crosswalk signs. The signs in front of Holy Infant are operational; however, due to a lack of replacement parts they have been repaired internally by staff numerous times and are likely to fail in the near future. Staff is looking for direction from the Board of Aldermen for direction as the replacement of these signs are not budgeted.
