Camp FAQs

What should I bring to camp? All campers MUST bring a lunch, snack, water bottle, sunscreen, a swimsuit, a towel and must wear closed-toed shoes. On Fridays, the Kona Ice Food Truck will be available to Campers at the Pointe, so bring money if you'd like to participate.

Can I find info about camp online? Yes. Visit the City of Ballwin's website at www.ballwin.mo.us/summercamps/ to register online and find camp information, dates, times, cost, and an online version of this guide

Do all campers have to be potty trained? Yes, all campers are required to be fully potty trained before beginning camp.

What do campers do for lunch? All campers must bring a non-perishable lunch daily, including a morning snack and drink. This is an outdoor camp, so package it appropriately to ensure the heat does not affect the food. No glass permitted.

How will I know what group my camper is in? We will be dividing groups by age: 5-6, 7-8, 9-10 and 11 - 14. Signs will be displayed at check in to direct campers to their age-specific group.

Does my child need to complete Kindergarten prior to camp? Yes, new for the 2024 Camp Season, all 5-year-olds must have already completed a year of Kindergarten in order to register for camp.

What is the camper to counselor ratio? To ensure all children are properly supervised we maintain a camper to counselor ratio of 8:1 for campers age 5-6 and 9:1 for campers age 7-14.

My child wants to purchase something from the North Pointe concessions stand, do I need to send cash? You can load a key fob with "Ballwin Bucks." This is a great alternative to cash and can be purchased at The Pointe or North Pointe.

Who do I contact if:

There is an issue with registration, I need a refund, or to transfer a registration? For all registration issues please contact the Camp Director at campdirector@ballwin.mo.us or 636.227.8950.

I need to add someone to a pick up list, speak with the Camp Director, or arrange a late drop off or early pick up. For all day-to-day issues, you can speak with the Camp Director at drop off or pick up. You can also call the camp cell phone at 314.581.2806. This phone will be available camp days from 7 a.m. - 6 p.m.

I need to speak to someone about medication, disability, or securing an inclusion support staff. For all questions related to inclusion services please contact Inclusive Recreation Coordinator Terri Johnson at tjohnson@desperesmo.org or 314.835.6157.

Get Registered

Registration for the 2024 Ballwin Summer Camps opens on Thursday, February 1, 2024 at 5 a.m online and 5:30 a.m. in person at the Pointe for VIP and/or Residents ONLY. All others are open to register February 15, 2023.

Space is limited and camps fill up quickly. Sign up early to secure your child's place, as there is no guarantee those waitlisted will be accepted. Registration closes the Monday before camp starts at noon.

Refund Requests

1. A full refund will be given to all registrants when a program is cancelled.
2. A prorated refund will be given to any registrant who cancels due to health reasons. A Doctor's note or health care confirmation letter is required to process a medical refund less a \$10 processing fee.
3. A \$20 fee will be assessed for all camp cancellations or transfers per camper, per week of camp. All requests must be received one week in advance of camp start date. NO refunds will be given for camp transfers or cancellations requested less than one week in advance of that camp.
4. All requests for cancellations or transfers must be made in writing or email to the Camp Director at campdirector@ballwin.mo.us.

Inclement Weather

Ballwin Summer Camp is an outdoor based camp. In the case of inclement weather camps will be moved inside The Pointe or The Ballwin Golf Course. In the case of high temperatures, camp will adapt a schedule of light activities and water games.

Drop Off/Pick Up

Please double check campers have their lunch, water bottle, appropriate shoes and clothing, and sunscreen.

Since some camps serve a large range of ages, campers will be divided into smaller sections based on their age. Counselors will greet you each morning and get your child checked in and placed into his or her group. When you register, you will have the opportunity to indicate who is allowed to pick up your camper at the end of the day. For campers' safety, counselors will only allow children to go home with someone who is on the safe pick up list. A photo ID is also required to check your child out of camp. Campers are required to be able to swim 25 yards unassisted and tread water for 2 minutes. If a camper does not meet the minimum swimming requirements, they will be transferred to Day Camp or Teen Camp with a \$20 transfer fee charged. Aqua Camp is NOT a substitute for swim lessons. No Club AM available for Aqua Camp.
